ELK VALLEY HOSTS SERIES OF SERIES SATS

Elk Valley Casino in Crescent City, Calif., is hosting three satellites to the 2018 World Series of Poker Main Event. The dates are March 2-3, April 6-7 and May 4-5 at this Northern California property. Each satellite costs \$250 and winners earn a \$10K main-event seat and will get \$2K for travel expenses. See the ad on Page 12 for more information.

JACKSON RANCHERIA: The Jackson poker room has one of the most affordable tournament schedules in the NorCal region with a reasonable \$2 entry fee on all of its daily events.

Mondays is a \$1.5K guarantee bounty tournament with a \$60 buy-in at 7 p.m. There are two events on Tuesdays, a \$40 Omaha/8 tourney at 11 a.m. and a \$1K guarantee for \$50 at 7:30. Wednesdays host a \$30 event at 11 a.m. and a \$1K guarantee at 7:30 for \$50.

On Thursdays, look for a crazy pineapple tourney at 11 a.m. for a \$30 buy-in and a \$50 satellite at 7:30 p.m. There is only one tournament on Fridays, a \$2K guarantee for \$60 at 11 a.m. Finally, on Saturdays, a \$60 bounty event runs at 11 a.m.

Jackson Rancheria also offers quarterly Points Championship tournaments where the top 36 point-earners over the three-month period will gain entry into the \$220 event for only \$20. These events have a \$4K guarantee. The Point Championship tournaments for the rest of the year will be April 15, July 15 and Oct. 21, all starting at 1 p.m.

NAPA VALLEY CASINO: There are numerous promotions at this American Canyon property, including a New Player Bonus that gives first-time players \$60 in chips for a \$30 buy-in based on two hours of play. The room also has a \$50K Monster Bad Beat (quad eights), a \$3K Easy Bad Beat (aces full of 10s) and a \$3K Omaha/8 Bad Beat (quad 10s).

STONES GAMBLING HALL: There's a \$50K guarantee Battle of the Ages Feb. 7-11. Call for details.

PACIFIC NORTHWEST

MUCKLESHOOT CASINO: The \$64K Tournament of Champions was Dec. 17 in Auburn, Wash., and brought together 80 players who qualified by winning one of the Sunday, Monday or Tuesday tournaments, 66 players who qualified by points and paid \$250, and 25 players who paid the \$400 buy-in. Muckleshoot contributed the remaining \$37.5K.

None of the top-three finishers were one of the freerollers as Ken Churchill of Auburn won the title and \$14K.

Looking ahead, Muckleshoot hosts its Spring Classic, which will have five tourneys, March 14-19.

CHINOOK WINDS CASINO: The PacWest Poker Classic will run

MEET ADRIANNE HALL

Poker dealer **Adrianne Hall** works at Ocean's 11 Casino in Oceanside, Calif. "I have been there about 16 months and I love it so much."

She has been playing since 2003; her dad taught her how to play Omaha on PokerStars. "I would watch him play for hours and he finally let me go and that was it. I fell in love."

Though she went to college multiple times and had a medical career, she was headed toward becoming a registered nurse when she realized, "I just wanted to play and deal poker for a living."

"My very first tournament was a limit tournament and I cashed. I cashed four tournaments in a row. What a crazy ride; I was hooked."

She recently had a nice string of successes: At the 2017 WSOP, she came in 25th in Event 1 (\$565 casino employees) for \$1,874. Hall also cashed in Event 47 (Monster Stack), finishing 412th out of 6,716 entries for \$4,235. Locally, she took sixth at the Hustler Casino's \$20K guarantee in July for (\$1,750).

"Other than poker, I love to sing. I tried out for *American Idol* in 2002 and almost made the show. I also love to play the piano." — **Kittie Aleman**

Feb. 17-25. It kicks off with a two-day \$380 event that sports a \$100K guarantee. Single-day events, all with guarantees, will be \$140 NLHE, \$330 NLHE, \$120 seniors, \$150 Omaha/8, \$100 bounty, \$150 pot-limit Big Omaha/8 and \$200 NLHE. The two-day \$500 main event begins Feb. 24 and has a \$200K guarantee.

Chinook Winds is in Lincoln, Ore., about 50 miles from Portland, and is the 13th-largest poker room in the region with seven tables. The poker room is closed Wednesdays and Thursdays but not during the series.

CLEARWATER CASINO: The Suquamish, Wash., property is a tribal casino with an eight-table poker room 18 miles northwest of Seattle that caters mostly to locals. Monthly tournaments include the \$100 Clearwater International event with \$3K added and the Clearwater888, which costs \$88 and the house adds \$888 if there are four or more tables sold.

JAFFEE GETS HIS FIRST RING AT THE BIKE

Tared Jaffee defeated a field of 687 entries to win the World Series of Poker Circuit Main Event at Bicycle Casino in Bell Gardens. He took home \$211,220, his first WSOPC ring and a seat into the Global Casino Championship.

Jaffee, 36, has a WSOP bracelet, too. He won Event 58 (\$1,500 Mixed Max) at the 2014 WSOP and has 31 cashes for more than a million dollars in earnings.

Other winners were William Collins (Event 1, \$365 NLHE, \$7K); Hermilo Vargas (Event 2, \$365 Monster Stack, \$71,195); Samuel Lee (Event 3, \$365 NLHE, \$9,900); Lang Lee (Event 4, \$580 NLHE, \$17,560); David Brookshire (Event 5, \$365 Omaha/8, \$8,285); **Ryan Van Sanford** (Event 6, \$365 NLHE, \$13,135); Xiao Ruan (Event 7, \$1,125 NLHE, \$28,195); Edward Liu (Event 8, \$365 NLHE, \$12,585); Calvin Roberts (Event 9, \$365 NLHE, \$16,970); Andrew Wisdom (Event 11, \$3,250 high roller, \$72,420) and Harry Arutyunyan (Event 12, \$580 NLHE, \$11,250).

CITY GALA: The third annual City Gala Celebrity Poker Tournament will be March 4 at Universal Studios in Hollywood. The 8 p.m. tournament costs \$500 and that includes dinner and an open bar. For more information, go to citygala.org.

LAS VEGAS

SOUTH POINT: There's a \$50K guarantee for \$250 with two starting flights, Feb. 1 and Feb. 2, with Day 2 on Feb. 3. Players get 10K chips and play 30-minute levels. You can enter both starting flights and if you qualify for Day 2 in both flights, you'll receive a bonus payout. If 10 players or fewer qualify twice, they'll each get \$1K. If 11 or more players qualify twice, they'll split \$10K.

Qualifying for the Spring freeroll begins Feb. 1 and runs through April 30. Players need 120 hours over the three months to qualify and are eligible for bonus payouts for additional hours played. More than \$190K in prize money will be awarded.

VENETIAN: This month, the room offers a loyalty-rewards promotion. In addition to the standard \$1 per hour in comps for live play, players will earn additional comps for a minimum of 25 hours of play during the period, starting at 50 cents for 25 hours, with an additional 50 cents for every increment of 25 hours up to 250 hours. For 250 hours of live play or more during the month, the extra reward is \$3 per hour.

BOULDER STATION: Bill Levy is the new manager. He's been with Stations for five years and at Boulder for more than three years, recently as a day-shift supervisor.

The most popular game here is the \$4-\$8 Omaha high with a half-kill. The minimum buy-in is \$40 and the action is wild. Always running is a \$2-\$4 limit game with a \$20 minimum buy-in. A \$1-\$2 NLHE game with a \$50-\$300 min-max runs during busier periods.

Levy is intent on offering exciting promotions. On Mondays, Tuesdays and Saturdays, the hold'em games award \$500 for flopping quads. Wednesdays and Thursdays award \$25 or \$50 for Aces Cracked. Four Flush Fridays offer \$100 for making a flush in each suit. Sundays offer \$200 for the high hand of the shift three times a day.

The Omaha promos are varied, too. On Mondays, the highest hand wins \$500. Progressive payouts for Steel Wheels are offered on Wednesday. High hand of the shift is worth \$200 on Thursdays. On Sunday, the highest hand is worth \$500. There's also an Omaha bad-beat jackpot and payouts for royals (\$100-\$300).

There also have been having drawings during Vegas Golden Knights games, giving away \$100 to a random hold'em player and a random Omaha player after the Knights score.

RIO: The World Series of Poker Circuit visits Feb. 16-27. The \$1,675 main event has a \$1M guarantee, with the first of its two starting flights Feb. 24. The opening event is a six-startingflight \$365 event with a \$250K guarantee beginning Feb. 16. It has unlimited re-entry. A \$2,200 high roller wraps up things

ARIA: The U.S. Poker Open runs Feb. 1-9. This is a series of high rollers. In addition to two \$10K and three \$25K NLHE events, there's a \$10K PLO event Feb. 2 and a \$25K Mixed Game Championship on Feb. 5. The \$50K main event is a three-day event beginning Feb. 9. The player who wins the most money during the series will be named the U.S. Poker Open Champion and will receive the U.S. Poker Open Cup.

WYNN: The Wynn Classic runs Feb. 19-March 11. New this time is a \$3,150 two-day NLHE event that starts Feb. 28. The \$1,600 championship event has the first of three starting flights on March 1. It has a \$1M guarantee. Most of the other tournaments have buy-ins of \$400 or \$550 with guarantees of between \$25K and \$250K. A \$400 PLO event with a \$25K guarantee runs Feb. 20.

ORLEANS: A new eight-game mix tournament runs Wednesday nights at 7:05. Players start with 15K chips and play 20-minute levels to start, going to 30 minutes beginning with Level 5. The games are NLHE, PLO, deuce-to-seven triple draw, Omaha/8, limit hold'em, stud, stud/8 and razz. The games change every six hands. This is the only regularly scheduled tournament of its type in Vegas.

BELLAGIO: Ryan Tosoc of Chicago won the WPT Five Diamond Classic in December, taking home nearly \$2M. Alex Foxen of New York took second for \$1.1M and Michael Del Vecchio from Las Vegas grabbed \$762K for third. The \$10,400 event drew 800-plus players and had a prize pool close to \$8M.







WSOPC COCONUT CREEK FEB. 8-19

After seven years and nine tournament series played at the Palm Beach Kennel Club in West Palm Beach, the WSOPC moves to Seminole Casino Coconut Creek for the first time Feb. 8-19. The kennel club was a spot for several exciting moments over the years, including a \$1M guarantee for the opening event in the second year. That tourney drew a massive crowd of 2,607 entrants, the largest tournament in Florida at that time.

Past champs from South Florida such as **Darryll Fish, Tristan Wade, Mukul Pahuja** and **Maurice Hawkins** likely will return for the \$1,675 main event, which has opening sessions Feb. 16-17 at noon and will feature a \$1M guarantee and one re-entry allowed per flight. Seminole Gaming General Manager of Poker Operations **Larry Frank** is thrilled to see the event arrive in Coconut Creek.

"The World Series of Poker is the largest and most historic name in the industry. As we continue to grow our poker brand throughout Florida and globally, the partnership with WSOP proves a natural fit for Seminole Gaming, further establishing our position as a premier destination for top poker play."

WSOP executive director **Ty Stewart** also expressed excitement at moving to the new venue.

"The poker pulse is strong in Florida and our partnership with Seminole Gaming has helped us expand our brand in the Sunshine State by working with two of its premiere properties," he said. "With a \$1M guaranteed main event taking place during peak season, the Seminole Casino Coconut Creek series is one of our most anticipated of the year."

The 12-day series will have a \$300K guarantee for Event 2 with four flights and a \$365 buy-in, plus a \$3,250 high roller (\$100K guarantee) and a \$365 PLO event with \$100 rebuys.

ISLE CASINO: The Pompano Beach poker room closed out the year with the 20-tournament Isle Classic with a distinctly different look, as the main event opened the series in the first week of December. The \$1,500 opener carried a \$300K guarantee

and fell just short of that number, attracting 196

NEW CASINOS ARE HOPING TO REVIVE ATLANTIC CITY

Atlantic City will be facing multiple new developments this year in hopes of reviving the city from its economic deficit. The Boardwalk will see major changes in preparation of two new casinos: the Hard Rock and the Ocean Resort Casino, which should open this summer. The casinos are focusing on ways to bring business to the city by offering heightened entertainment attractions, a music memorabilia museum and sports gambling.

Though half of Atlantic City's casinos have closed over the past decade, there still are six casinos operating in spite of more casinos rising in the surrounding regions.

The city is looking for ways to revive its economy by increasing property assets and management toward boosting the community.

The former Showboat Casino had a \$220M transformation and became Stockton University and the demolition of the former Trump Plaza most likely will be this year to revitalize the property at the center of the Boardwalk.

OCEAN RESORT CASINO: Revel, which opened in 2012 and had a poker room, went bankrupt after two years. The \$2.4B property was picked up by **Glenn Straub**, a Florida businessman, for \$82M in 2015 then recently sold for \$200M to **Bruce Deifik** of Integrated Properties Inc., in 2017.

Deifik plans to establish a sportsbook facility, pending U.S. Supreme Court's approval. Atlantic City is making a slow recovery through online gaming, which has been yielding gaming revenue growth over the years.

Boardwalk casinos stay hopeful with the outlook of new amenities and sports gambling in the near future. The Ocean Resort could employ 3,000 people.

HARD ROCK: New management of the casino once known as Trump Taj Mahal began after New Jersey Casino Control Commission approved gaming operations.

The property will get a \$500M renovation, likely with a poker room, for its reopening as Hard Rock Hotel & Casino on Memorial Day Weekend. The project should generate 1,000 construction jobs and 3,000 permanent jobs.

BORGATA: Fernando Lima of Severn, Md., and **Suresh Suryawanshi** of Charles Town. W.Va., chopped the \$100K guarantee deepstack on Dec. 30 for nearly \$30K each.

The \$400 event drew 436 players for a \$152,600 prize pool. At press time, the Winter Open was running and wraps Feb. 2.

HARRAH'S CASINO: The World Series of Poker Circuit returns March 8-19. In the meantime, the poker room hosts \$65 events at 8:15 p.m. on Sundays and Wednesdays with \$2,500 guarantees.

VALLEY FORGE CASINO RESORT: Recent passed legislation allows this Philadelphia-area property to add 250 slot machines and 15 poker tables. It also can apply for online gaming and sportsbetting licenses as they become available.

The casino has a 40,000 square-foot gaming floor and two hotel towers. Stay tuned for updates. \spadesuit

AURORA TOC GOES TO SCULLY IN ILLINOIS

The Hollywood Aurora Tournament of Champions is one of Chicagoland's most unique tournaments, as weekly tournament winners and the runners-up advance to the TOC every December.

Ryan Scully, who has been a familiar sight at these final tables, recently won \$7K-plus and the huge TOC trophy.

In other tourney news, every Wednesday at noon Hollywood runs its \$160 tournament, which is Chicagoland's longest running tournament, starting in March 2005.

INDIANA NEWS: Penn National Gaming has acquired Ameristar East Chicago and Belterra Casino, along with 14 other Pinnacle Entertainment gaming and entertainment facilities in 10 states for \$2.8B.

Penn National Gaming, which owns Hollywood Casino in Lawrenceburg, sold Belterra to Boyd Gaming, overcoming a regularity hurdle in Indiana. Boyd Gaming, which owns Blue Chip, will have two poker rooms in Indiana.

MAJESTIC STAR: There's a new weekly tournament lineup with improved blind structures. See the Where to Play section in the back of this issue for more info. Also, the bad-beat jackpot at press time was nearly \$70K (aces full of kings).

MICHIGAN

MARSH WINS RECORD EVENT IN MINNESOTA

Ben Marsh of Duluth, Minn., won his second Mid-States Poker Tour title after besting a record-setting field of 493 entries at Canterbury Park in Shakopee, Minn.

Marsh, a 32-year-old pro, took home his largest career cash of \$102,493 from the \$476,710 prize pool. He beat the largest field in a \$1K-plus event in Minnesota history. Marsh also became the ninth player to win more than one MSPT title, winning his first at Treasure Island Resort and Casino in 2011.

"I am feeling pretty great," said Marsh, who spends most of his time playing online. "I haven't played a ton of live poker this year and didn't have any luck when I did. This is only my second tournament since the World Series in Las Vegas."

Marsh faced a tough final table filled with local pros and tough amateurs, including Jonathan Hanner, Rajaee Wazwaz, Brian Berthiaume, Vladimir Revniaga and David Gonia. Marsh got headsup with Hanner with roughly even stacks, but Marsh quickly pulled ahead with a decent lead. Hanner raised with A-K and Marsh defended with 10-9. The flop came 9-4-K and Hanner bet; Marsh called. The turn was a nine. Marsh led out and

Hanner called. An inconsequential five came on the river. Marsh moved all-in and Hanner

hesitantly called off his remaining stack. **RUNNING ACES: Zachary Waldvogel** of Minneapolis won \$13,106 and the trophy at the Cold Hard Cash tournament. The event featured six \$280 Day 1 flights and offered a

\$1,200 buy-back of small stacks if a player made it to Day 2 with multiple stacks. There was an eight-way chop, at which time Waldvogel was the shortest stack, leaving a little money and the trophy for first place.

Robert Van Syckle of St. Paul took second. The event drew 703 players and generated a \$143,031 prize pool.





There's no substitute for high volume, focused practice with detailed feedback. APT will analyze your play to help set and achieve goals. Even if you've broken your New Year's resolutions, it's never too late to begin working on SMART goals.

NEVER TRY TO BLUFF A CALLING STATION

Even the best players can't convince "calling stations" to fold as they are incapable of understanding or realizing this concept. So the best advice would be to curtail your efforts and

take steps to avoid wasting your time and chips. Tactics work better on players who consciously notice pot odds, know whether their starting hands have worth or expected improvement possibilities, concepts that avid calling stations don't consider.

Let's be clear about bluffing and semibluffing, and define what we mean. A bluff entails making a sizeable bet that's designed to make your opponent fold and your hand has

no chance of winning the pot if called. To semibluff means you have a hand that has potential of improving and winning if called, however, you are attempting to win the pot on that round of betting.

Should you fail to convince your opponent to fold, you have outs to improve and still win the hand, or if you miss, to bluff and try to win the hand anyway.

When you play against players oblivious to your strategies,

they will ruin your attempts to control the pot and manipulate the table into doing what you want. Therefore, making these moves against a calling station will result in frustration for the bettor and hilarious comments at the table or in the chat box.

Players who play any ace and any two suited cards or basically any two cards, usually are lurking at your table, whether online or live, and identifying your common opponents will make your task a bit easier and save you chips.

On the flip side, when you're up against a calling station, you can extract extra value on those hands when they don't connect. Overcharge them to stay; remember, you don't want lots of them in your pot holding one pair. And when you lose (occasionally), show sportsmanship and realize you'll have chances to get your money back and more if that player stays at your table. Nothing creates more tilt at the tables than losing to calling station with two awful cards, so it becomes your priority to not let it happen.

A LIST OF THINGS YOU NEVER SHOULD DO

When you're a recurring presence in your home poker room, people get to know you and some may look up to you. It's extremely important to become a role model for aspir-

ing pros and avoid being a pariah. Here's how:



BRENT PHILBIN

DON'T BERATE PLAYERS: I've harped on this before, but I believe in it so much. There's abso-

lutely no good reason to berate players. Control yourself and act like an adult, and say "nice hand," ironically.

DON'T YELL AT THE DEAL-

ER: You became a pro, remember? You clearly understand variance and that a dealer has nothing to do with that, right? Oh, and if you've ever thrown cards at a dealer, just quit poker. Save your ire for dealers with a bad attitude.

SHOW YOUR CARDS AT SHOWDOWN: Yeah, I get it. You want the most information

possible. Causing a standoff by refusing to show your cards "until it's your turn" only hurts your game and your bottom line, and you'll gain little information. If the floor ever needs to get involved, you are 100 percent in the wrong. Remember, you're the pro.

STOP WHINING: Invariably, during every session you play, someone will gripe about not seeing a beverage server for 45 minutes. They were there and you weren't paying attention. How

is this possible? Well, you're a pro so you're watching the game at all times and trying to gain information. Unless a server happened to come by during the shuffle, you were busy.

DON'T SAY DEALER: Every dealer has a name tag. If you need to address them, use it to discover their secret identity. If you can't ascertain it, use something else to get their attention. The

way you're saying it is derogatory and it's

often followed up with a suggestion on how they do their job.

DON'T TANK: Tanking has gotten slightly better, but tanking is an absolute epidemic to which you should not contribute. Once one person has annoyed the table with a tank, it will entice a reciprocal tank and eventually you're playing six hands an hour. There will be, once in a blue moon, a decision that requires you to take a while to think. Apologize to the table and take your time. Don't tank for tank's sake.

DON'T YELL ACROSS THE ROOM: If you feel the need to celebrate after a win, you're not a pro. Running around the room screaming "One time!" (Of course, you didn't even say that until after the river card came out, which is clearly not how it works.) when you win a pot makes you the butt of every joke in the room for five minutes. Stop it.

COACH'S CORNER

HERE'S A MENTAL EXERCISE TO PLUG LEAKS

I enjoy receiving emails from players, so if you happen to be reading this column while at the table, make a mental note to shoot me an email. By the time players see this, it might

be four or five weeks after we have made our poker resolutions.

There's a strong chance that if you're an aspiring player or even a high-stakes pro, there are resolutions that were made that, after two or three weeks, you started to get back into your old habits.

Remember my last column that focused on old habits dying hard? I have a few fresh ideas

on how to go about changing a few habits that will prove effective.

Imagine we have five resolutions and while we have made some headway, we know that in our heart of hearts, we could be doing better and our promises are turning in to empty ones. This will be a profitable exercise even if you didn't make resolutions.

IDEA 1: Many of us start the year with a whole bunch of ideas

and, while our plan looks great on paper, when we're overtasked, we tend to get paralyzed. It's sort of like tilt. Our brains simply shut down. Let's organize our "needs improvement areas" into a top five.

When we have our notions bullet-pointed, show them to your poker peers or mentors at an appropriate time and ask help in ranking these items in order of importance.

Don't forget to make a case for each area being identified as the most crucial leak to eliminate in 2018. Sell each idea hard and make sure all are given equal consideration. Ask peers to order the leaks in which they think are most important. After you get votes tallied, resolve yourself to tackle each leak one at a time. If you perform this task, your hourly earn rate will improve, maybe even skyrocket.

IDEA 2: Send me your list and remember to sell each point as if it were a matter of life or death. I'd like to be part of your team to help yourself prioritize which leaks come first. Happy hunting and may 2018 bring you lots of stacks.

YOU'RE NOT GOOD ENOUGH TO WIN WITH ONE CARD?

We were in a tournament in an Atlantic City casino and I was dealt just one card. I asked the dealer where my other card was and she said, "I don't know, look for it."

I looked everywhere but couldn't find it. The floor said it

was on me and I could fold or call the 1,300 bet in front of me. Everyone got a laugh. As a goof, I called the bet and the player next to me high-fived me. I did not improve on the flop and folded. — **Brian Taylor, via email**

ELLIOTT SAID: How very generous of that dealer to let you continue with only one card. Most times, too many or too few cards in a hand render that hand dead.

If you started the hand with two cards, where did the other card go? I'm sure the supervisor and the gaming commission are at least a little curious. In a tournament, it would have been a misdeal. After the action starts, any player that knowingly plays a hand with too many or too few cards, has a dead hand and forfeits any chips bet in that hand. This player usually has surveillance watching them closely for the rest of the session, to boot. "Players must protect their hands at all times" is just a long way of stating, "Pay attention!"

It's all about timing

The dealer deals everyone's hole cards and after all are dealt,

Seat 5 looks at his cards and says he thinks he saw a face card dealt to Seat 3. The dealer asks Seat 3 to look at his cards and if he had a face card to muck it. Seat 3 throws out a queen and the dealer gives him a new card.

Why did Seat 5 announce after he looked at his cards? What if Seat 3 had two face cards? Player 5 couldn't identify the card he said he saw other than it was paint. — Frank Simone, via email

ELLIOTT SAID: This did not go well for the players at the table. First, the proper time to call attention to a mistake is when it happens. Waiting until the cards were all out makes it appear more pot-shot than correction.

You didn't say other players spoke up so I'm going to assume none did. That isn't insignificant. Second, why did the dealer do anything other than call for the supervisor? This isn't a simple case of replacing an exposed card.

The situation entered ruling territory with the delay in calling attention to the card, the virtual inability of anyone being able to identify the card and the absence of any corroboration of a card being exposed.

Based upon your brief description of what happened, I believe the correct call would have been to let the card stay in the player's hand and to continue.



January was a big month for some of poker's biggest celebrities and here's our take on the latest from Vanessa Selbst, Daniel Negreanu, Kevin Hart and Jason Mercier.

SELBST QUITS POKER

Vanessa Selbst is giving up poker to become a hedge-fund trader and will no longer be on Team PokerStars. She cited the time required to keep up with the changing game and the toll constant travel was having on her.

SCOTT SAID: Why don't we see this happen more often? To the degree that we have seen it, it's with players who have passions outside of poker or find whatever it is that they loved about poker elsewhere. So I think the ones we don't see do this are the ones who have focused 100 percent of their lives on poker and have no other options than making poor investments in friends' stupid business plans. If you have no other option, it's tougher to quit. CHRIS SAID: But she's not giving up poker; she's giving up professional poker. She's going to keep it, as she says, "an awesome hobby on the side." So she can still go down to the local casino and make \$6K a night just fooling around in a \$2-\$5 game.

MERCIER LEAVES STARS Jason Mercier did not renew his contract with Team PokerStars so can spend more time with his wife, Natasha, and their 3-monthold child. He'll continue to play near his home in Florida and at the

World Series of Poker.

SCOTT SAID: Mad props to Jason for stepping down and understanding he wants to see his child grow up. People in a lot of professions, and not just poker, wake up someday with the Cat's in the Cradle song playing and have missed out on all that.

CHRIS SAID: Have you noticed? Two spots have opened up on Team PokerStars. There's you and me! These players are stepping aside so you and I can reach our potential!

DID IT TAKE A LOT OF HART?

In what's being called the "greatest hand in poker history," comedian Kevin Hart made a hero call with kinghigh to felt a player who was bluffing with six-high. Did Hart misread his hand? Or was he operating on a higher level as he claims?

CHRIS SAID: I watched the hand. I laughed, I cried. He had to know. He had to think he had a straight. He would've folded with king-high on every street, no matter how much he thought she was bluffing. He's a comedian. I think he was being entertaining.

SCOTT SAID: She ran a really good bluff with six-high, I think. This wasn't the famous **Barry Greenstein** story where he put his opponent on a busted straight draw, so he knew he had six high so his hand was better. There is no way you could have put this woman on six-high here. Impossible.

NEGREANU'S LOSING YEARS

Daniel Negreanu posted on his blog that he has lost money in tournaments each of the past two years, but is still up nearly \$9M over the past five years.

SCOTT SAID: This shows the variance involved in being a tournament poker player, and there are very few better tournament players than Daniel Negreanu. You have have to be able to deal with those swings. CHRIS SAID: It's ridiculous. One of the things he talks about is that high-roller buy-ins are killing him. The average buy-in for his tournaments was \$40K. This is why it's amazing that you don't see more people doing what Vanessa Selbst did: the travel, the buy-ins, the swings.
